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Introduction:

Canadian International School of Hong Kong has established itself as one of the top international schools in Asia. As one of Hong Kong's largest and most respected English language schools, CDNIS has attracted students representing more than 40 nationalities, creating a unique learning environment that enhances the cultural bonds that draw the school together.

CDNIS was established as a non-profit organization in 1991 following a request from the local government to serve the Canadian community in Hong Kong. An International Baccalaureate (IB) World School, we offer the Diploma Programme (DP) for Grades 11 and 12 students and the Middle Years Programme (MYP) for Grades 7 to 10.

In addition to the IB Diploma Programme, the Upper School is inspected annually by the Ontario Ministry of Education and is authorized to grant credits for the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD). From Grade 9 to Grade 12, students follow academic credit courses leading to the OSSD.

The goal at CDNIS is for all students to graduate with both the OSSD and IB Diploma, which will position them well for the transition to post secondary education. For the Class of 2017, 98% completed the IB Diploma, and 100% completed the OSSD. The average IB result of the class was 36.7 points, with two students earning the maximum of 45 points, three earning 44 points, and 28 earning 40-43 points.

CDNIS Campus:

CDNIS is located in Aberdeen and overlooks Aberdeen Harbour, the Lamma Channel and outlying islands. The Lower School and Upper School are located on the same campus and occupy 14 floors. The campus also includes a 604-seat theatre, two gymnasiums, a weight training and fitness area, a dance studio, a 25-metre swimming pool, an artificial turf field, and several outdoor playing areas.

CDNIS Upper School Faculty:

There are 91 faculty members with over 57% holding a Master's degree or higher. The student/faculty ratio in the Upper School is 8:1, with the average Grade 12 class size numbering 15 students. Four counsellors are assigned to advise students in Grades 10-12, with two counsellors advising Grades 7-9.

Extra-Curricular Activities:

An active and extensive extra-curricular programme of more than 70 activities is offered to meet the various needs and interests of our students. This dynamic programme includes a comprehensive inter-school sports programme, a rich array of performing arts opportunities, school clubs including Habitat for Humanity and Model United Nations and a full complement of intramural and recreational activities.
